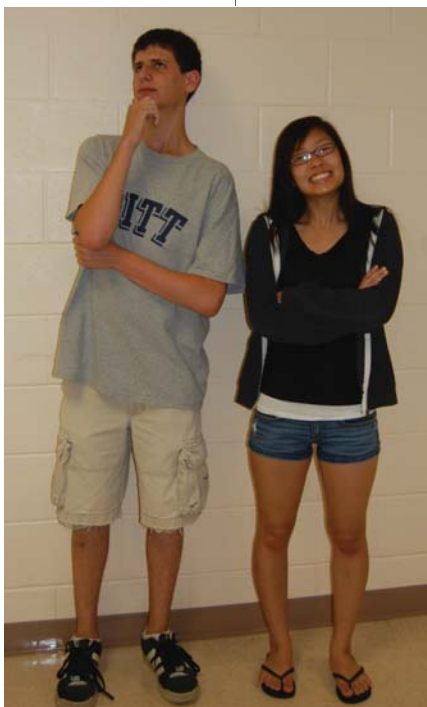

choose, just make sure that you don't sell yourself short.

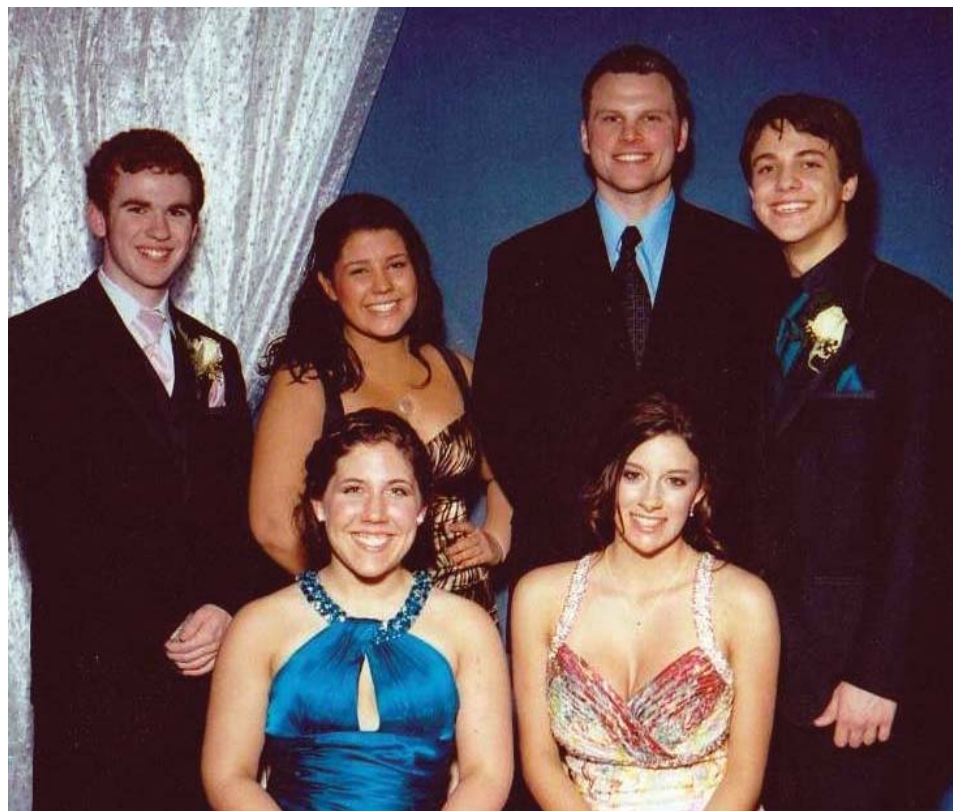
You have more potential than you realize. I am so very proud to have been a part of your lives.
